### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

A. Sign Code Update/Housing Code Update

Planning Manager Stephen Neuenschwander presented outreach efforts, survey findings, proposed design standards and clutter management tools for the sign code update.

The Planning Commission has a few more meetings to review and will hold a public hearing on November 20, and will come back before City Council for consideration in December.

He then provided a brief update for the housing code. Makers is continuing to look at scale and compatibility issues, protecting the homes that are in place. Single-family residences will continue to be allowed in Residential High density areas. This will come back before the City Council in October for consideration.

# B. Climate Change Update

Executive Services Director Allison Williams provided an overview of the city's green efforts. Staff has been working on an update to Resolution No. 2010-44, and Directors have been reviewing and working towards measurements and more specificity. With tomorrow's climate change rally planned in front of city hall tomorrow, staff put together a list of green efforts across the city.

# C. Overview of House Bill 1406 and Next Steps

Executive Services Director Allison Williams presented an overview of HB 1406, which allows a rebate of sales tax for affordable housing. It was the consensus of the Council to prepare a Resolution of intent to start the process for the program.
