

## ***Park Watch Goals***

The Park Watch program seeks to involve City residents in the use and protection of their City Parks.

In an effort to curtail incidents of trash dumping, vandalism, theft, graffiti and destruction of City park property, the Park Watch program empowers volunteers to report such incidents when they see them.

## ***Reporting***

To report suspicious or illegal activity, call **(509) 663-9911**.

To report damage or vandalism, call **(509) 888-3284**.

If the situation is an emergency or serious offense, **dial 9-1-1**.

When reporting a violation of these rules, try to include specific details, such as:

- \* Date and time of the incident.
- \* Description of the subjects.
- \* Description of the vehicles involved including make, model, color and license plate number.

**Under no circumstance should you confront the offender.**

A community involvement program for safety, security and protection in Wenatchee City Parks

## Park Watch Volunteers

As a resident of the City of Wenatchee living near a City Park, you are in a unique position to both enjoy and help protect the park.

Although City of Wenatchee Police Officers patrol near the park on a regular basis, security cameras are in many of the parks and Park Maintenance personnel are frequently in the park, they may not see everything that you see.

As a Park Watch Volunteer, you can assist the City of Wenatchee by informing them of illegal activities you see in the park.

## Your Safety...

...is our biggest concern. So as a Park Watch volunteer, you would not need to get involved in stopping any illegal activity. Instead, you can make a significant difference by simply calling the City of Wenatchee Police non-emergency line and reporting suspicious or illegal activity. Your name will not be shared with the offender.



## Park Rules

City of Wenatchee Parks are governed by rules listed in Wenatchee Municipal Code 6A.18.

The following are just a few Park Rules:

- Parks are open from 6:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.
- The following activities are prohibited:
  - Campfires;
  - Sales and rentals;
  - Signposting and solicitation;
  - Littering;
  - Alcoholic beverages and drugs;
  - Destruction or removal of property;
  - Fireworks;
- Overnight camping and aircraft are allowed with an approved Special Event Permit.
