Action Requested: Staff recommends the City Council approve Ordinance 2020-32 amending the 2020 budget as adopted by Ordinance 2019-39 and amended by ordinance 2020-14, revoking, recalling or decreasing all or a portion of total appropriations provided for, entering findings that this ordinance is in the best interest of the City and requiring that this Ordinance be approved by a majority plus one of the entire Council.

F. Temporary interfund lending of cash in 2021

Action Requested: Staff recommends the City Council pass Resolution 2020-37, authorizing the temporary lending of cash from the General Fund to the CDBG Entitlement Fund, Police Station GO Bond Fund, and various other funds as needed in 2021.
