#### I. CALL TO ORDER

Vice Chair Emilka Furmanczyk called the meeting to order at 5:32 p.m. with the following board members in attendance: Adriana Farnsworth, and James Snyder. City staff was represented by: Cliff Burdick, Building and Fire Code Official, Eric Mudgett, Code Compliance Officer, Kevin Kinman, Code Compliance Officer, and Yolanda Garcia, Code Compliance Coordinator.

#### II. ADMINISTRATIVE AFFAIRS

A. Approval of the minutes from the last regular meeting on September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021.

Board member James Snyder moved to approve the minutes of the regular meeting of September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2021. Board member Adriana Farnsworth seconded the motion. The motion carried.

#### IV. NEW BUSINESS

Vice Chair Furmanczyk provided an explanation of public hearing procedures and the appearance of fairness.

Vice Chair Furmanczyk swore in City Staff.

#### A. 21-361 – 214 Snohomish Street – Tammy Aviles

Eric Mudgett, Code Compliance Officer, and Cliff Burdick, Building and Fire Code Official, presented the staff report.

The respondent was present to address the Board and violations.

Mrs. Aviles stated renter Miguel Campos has a drug and alcohol problem; she mentioned she wasn't sure if she would be able to evict Mr. Campos at this time. Mrs. Aviles also stated her husband has health issues, and she's disabled, therefore; it's been difficult to bring the property into compliance.

Miguel Campos, renter, asked to speak to the board. Mr. Campos stated he has gone to rehab and is in a good state to start working on the property. Mr. Campos showed pictures (via his phone) of the work he's has done so far. Mr. Campos apologized to Mrs. Aviles

Vice Chair Furmanczyk closed the hearing and opened deliberations of the Board.

Board member Adriana Farnsworth moved that the Board, having heard the case and facts presented, find that the respondent is in violation of Wenatchee City Code and that a mandatory fee of \$150.00 be imposed. Board member James Snyder second the motion. The motion carried.

Board member James Snyder moved that the respondent be given until the 1<sup>st</sup> of December, 2021, to correct the violations of the Wenatchee City Code. After the 1<sup>st</sup> of December, 2021, a monetary penalty of \$100.00 per day shall be imposed for each code violation, for a period of 30 days, or until the violation has been corrected, for each code violation. If the time frame expires and the property is still in violation, the Board authorizes the City to abate the violation. Board member James Snyder seconded the motion. The motion carried.

B. 21-586 – 1005 Russell Street – Lauretta Sherwood c/o Tina Pasek

Eric Mudgett, Code Compliance Officer, and Cliff Burdick, Building and Fire Code Official, presented the staff report.

The respondent was not present to address the Board and violations.

Board member James Snyder moved that the Board, having heard the case and facts presented, find that the respondent is in violation of Wenatchee City Code and that a mandatory fee of \$150.00 be imposed. Board member Adriana Farnsworth second the motion. The motion carried.

Board member Adriana Farnsworth moved that the respondent be given until the 10<sup>th</sup> of November, 2021, to correct the violations of the Wenatchee City Code. After the 10<sup>th</sup> of November, 2021, a monetary penalty of \$100.00 per day shall be imposed for each code violation, for a period of 30 days, or until the violation has been corrected, for each code violation. If the time frame expires and the property is still in violation, the Board authorizes the City to abate the violation. Board member James Snyder seconded the motion. The motion carried.
