Have you been curious about what is happening on Springwater Avenue to the west of Western Avenues this summer? A LOT has been happening and we have some details about this project and what it will look like when it's all wrapped up.

This \$4M Street Improvement Project is partially grant funded by the Transportation Improvement Board (TIB). The project includes:

- Pavement widening
- Dedicated bike lanes in both directions
- Street Lighting
- Curbs and Sidewalks
- Storm drainage improvements.



The additional sidewalk and bike lanes will connect with the existing sidewalks along Western Ave and create a continuous pedestrian access between the Wenatchee Foothills and the Valley North shopping center to the east. These additional improvements continue to expand the City's routes of multimodal travel throughout this neighborhood. The project is anticipated to be complete by the end of 2023.
