A. Ordinance No. 2023-28 – amendments to the 2023 budget

Motion by Councilmember Linda Herald for City Council to pass Ordinance 2023-28 amending the 2023 Budget as adopted by Ordinance No. 2022-28, as amended by Ordinance No. 2023-06 and 2023-21, to revoke, recall or decrease all or a portion of total appropriations provided, and entering findings that this Ordinance is in the best interest of the City. Councilmember Travis Hornby seconded the motion. Motion carried (7-0).
