## DECLARATION OF STORM WATER SYSTEM MAINTENANCE COVENANTS FOR [Plat Name]

The Grantors, Owners and Developers of [*Plat Name*], hereby declare and agree as follows:

1. The Grantors are the Owners and Developers of the following described real property located at Douglas County, Washington:

2. The Grantors have designed and constructed a private storm water drainage system to serve the above real property in accordance with the plans Grantors have filed with Douglas County. The approved plans are attached hereto as **Exhibit A.** 

3. The Grantors agree to maintain the storm water drainage system as originally designed, and in accordance with the Douglas County Code and the specifications attached hereto as **Exhibit B.** The Grantors shall not reduce, expand or otherwise modify the design or operation of the storm water drainage system without first obtaining review by and written approval of Douglas County.

4. The Grantors agree to implement a long-term funding mechanism to support operation, maintenance, repairs and improvements required for proper functioning of the private storm water drainage system. Such funding mechanism shall be implemented by creation of an Owner's Association by further declarations and covenants binding upon the real property described above, all lots within the above development and Grantors' purchasers, successors and assigns.

5. The Grantors agree to maintain logs of inspection and maintenance activities for the storm water drainage system and to submit copies of the logs to Douglas County not less than once each calendar year.

6. All inspection and maintenance logs, and other documents and records pertaining to 1 the storm water drainage system shall, upon request, be made available to Douglas 2 County and any other agencies having jurisdiction for inspection and copying. 3 4 5 7. Douglas County shall have the right to enter the above-described real property for the purpose of inspecting the condition and/or maintenance of the storm water 6 drainage system and/or to determine the Grantors' compliance with these 7 8 Covenants. The Grantors agree to fully comply with all written notices of corrective action issued by Douglas County and other agencies having jurisdiction. If the 9 10 Grantors fail to fully and timely comply as required by a written notice of corrective action, then Douglas County may enter the above-described property to perform all 11 work necessary to fully complete repairs and maintenance to the storm water 12 drainage system or otherwise bring the system into compliance with these 13 Covenants. The Grantors agree to pay all costs and expenses incurred by Douglas 14 County for such repairs and maintenance, including the cost of personnel, 15 equipment and materials and Douglas County's contractors. 16 17 8. The Grantors hereby waive any and all claims for damages against Douglas County 18 arising from the design, construction, inspection, repair and/or maintenance of the 19 storm water drainage system. The Grantors agree to indemnify, defend and hold 20 Douglas County harmless from any and all claims arising from the design, 21 construction, inspection, repair and/or maintenance of the storm water drainage 22 23 system. 24 9. These Covenants shall continue in perpetuity. 25 26 27 10.
